



Amsterdam House, New York, NY

Amsterdam Nursing Home is one of the oldest long-term care facilities in New York City. Situated Across the street from the Cathedral of Saint John the Divine, it provides an elegant program-rich environment for the 406 residents in its intermediate and skilled care facilities. Next to the new 13 story addition is their Adult Day Health Center.

A new adult day care program constructed for 35-40 clients in a comprehensive center adjacent to the nursing home's addition. Its services include access to ambulatory health care, physical and occupational therapy, as well as dining, social and recreational programs.

The site for the addition was previously occupied by an abandoned Gatehouse structure—Part of the old Croton Adueduct system. This landmark quality structure has been restored to house the day care program. A new linier garden extends along Amsterdam Avenue. The new 13 story addition is a refined interpretation in brick cast in concrete panels and cast stone quoin of the 1912-1918 Morningside Heights apartment house structures.
