



Mt. Kisco Elementary School, Bedford, NY

Mt. Kisco Elementary School was founded in 1888 as a Kindergarten through Twelfth Grade community school. It was rebuilt after World War I in two phases as an elementary school. Along the way, due to population pressure, the library continued to move to make room for needed classrooms. Undersized and awkward to use, there was an impetus from the community to reconstruct the building as a whole, build a new classroom wing, build an auditorium and establish a library and technology center in the heart of the school.

To accomplish this, we moved school lunches out of the former auditorium, all purpose room in the center of the school. In this location, we established a large new library along with adjacent technology and computer classrooms. It is literally and figuratively in the heart of the school right off the main historic entrance.
